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**Ben's Centre** is run by a small team of staff and volunteers who provide free breakfasts, lunches, clothes, support, sign posting and advocacy. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday 10.30–2.30pm at 15 North Church Street.

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**HARC (Homeless and Rootless at Christmas)** provides a safe haven for vulnerable and homeless men and women from Christmas Eve through to New Year's Day, providing three hot meals a day, and other services such as a podiatrist, hairdresser, clothing store and entertainment.
